GUIDELINES ON INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED OR LEFT FOR ASSUMPTIONS IN THE MORNING SESSION OF THE PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

This aide-memoire is to assist consistency of information given and required and is designed to enable all Groups to have a similar format. The essential principle here is to distinguish between those points that a professional valuer should be able to identify from his own knowledge as opposed to those points on which he would naturally ask a client for information.
